Tuesday 13th March

The Pitt Rivers and Ashmolean Museums **University of Oxford**

Our day in Oxford begins with time for coffee before entering the Pitt Rivers Museum for an introductory talk. On display are archaeological and ethnographic objects from all parts of the world and all time periods – a truly global collection gifted by Lt.-General Pitt Rivers to Oxford University. After the introduction, we will have time to explore the extensive collection at leisure.

We later walk across to the Ashmolean Museum of Art and Archaeology, to enjoy a specialist guided gallery tour on their Chinese Collection, followed by free time to visit other areas of the Museum.

The walk between the two museums takes approximately 10–15 minutes.

NB Refreshments and lunch are not included in the visit price, but there are many venues in the area and we will receive 10% discount in the Ashmolean cafe and the Museum shop.

We will board the coach at 4.15 pm for our return journey.
